#### MUNICIPAL BY-LAW NO. 2019-01

# VILLAGE OF DOAKTOWN BY-LAW DESIGNATING PORTIONS OF ROADS ACCESSIBLE TO OFF-ROAD VEHICLES.

Pursuant to the powers conferred by the Off-Road Vehicle Act, S.N.B. 1985, c.0-1.5 and its amendments, the Council of the Village of Doaktown duly assembled enacts as follows:

### Definitions:

1. "Off-Road Vehicle" has the same meaning as defined in the Off-Road VehicleAct.

General provisions:

- No person shall drive an Off-Road Vehicle on the Storeytown Road, Hazelton Road, Riverview Drive, and South Road, other than at the locations designated for this purpose and as further set out below and on a map attached to this By-Law as Schedule "A".
  (Full map)
- 3. Off-Road Vehicles shall only be driven on or along Storeytown Road, designated as municipal jurisdiction, for a distance of 2930 metres and further set out on a map attached to this By-Law as Schedule "B" at a speed not exceeding 40 km/h.
- Off-Road Vehicles shall only be driven on or along Hazelton Road, designated as municipal jurisdiction for a distance of 530 metres and further set out on a map attached to this by-law as Schedule "C" at a speed not exceeding 40 km/h.
- 5. Off-Road Vehicles shall only be driven on or along Riverview Drive, designated as municipal jurisdiction, for a distance of 485 metres and further set out on a map attached to this by-law as Schedule "D" at a speed not exceeding 40 km/h.
- 6. Off-Road Vehicles shall only be driven on or along South Road, designated as municipal jurisdiction, for a distance of 3060 metres and further set out on a map attached to this by-law as Schedule "E" at a speed not exceeding 40 km/h.
- No person shall drive an Off-Road Vehicle on the traveled portion of Storeytown Road, Hazelton Road, Riverview Drive and South Road at a location which is not designated to that effect.
- 8. The driver or any occupant of the Off-Road Vehicle shall be properly wearing a helmet that complies with the standards prescribed as per the *Motor VehicleAct*.
- 9. Off-Road Vehicles shall display a valid trail permit as required under the Off-Road Vehicle Act or a valid trail permit from another province having a reciprocal agreement with New Brunswick.
- 10. Off-Road Vehicles shall be outfitted with the necessary equipment as per the Off-Road Vehicle Act.
- 11. Off-Road Vehicles shall operate in the same direction as traffic and travel in a single file to the extreme right of the road.

- 12. Off-Road Vehicle drivers shall give the appropriate signals as required under the *Motor Vehicle Act* and obey all traffic control devices.
- Off-Road Vehicle drivers shall come to a complete stop before entering the travelled portion of the roadway and shall give the right-of-way to all other vehicles utilizing the roadway.
- 14. No person shall operate an Off-Road vehicle on the traveled portion of Storeytown Road, Hazelton Road, Riverview Drive or South Road unless they are in possession of a valid driver's license.

#### Offence:

15. Any person who violates sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 or 14 of this By-Law is guilty of an offence and is liable upon summary conviction to a fine of \$100.00

## Coming into force:

 This By-Law comes into force upon the approval of the Minister as defined under the Off-Road Vehicle Act.

# By-Law 2017-03 is hereby repealed and replaced with By-Law 2019-01.
