



Since opening in late June, the Salmon Museum and its staff have been exceptionally busy welcoming back old friends, working on some new exhibits, and just generally learning how to operate under the “new normal.” We want everyone to feel safe during your time with us, so we’ve made sure there are plenty of disposable masks, gloves, and hand sanitizers available whenever you need them. Above all else, please remember to respect the 6’ distancing requirement while on our premises. Our hours are as they have always been:

Monday – Saturday: 9 am – 5 pm / Sunday: Noon – 5:00 pm
We regret that our Aquarium facility will not be operating this season.

Chase the Ace is continuing at the Museum with a few important changes. First of all, draws will be held on **THURSDAY** evenings at approximately 8:00 pm and, because of COVID-19 gathering restrictions, we are trying our hand at live-streaming (we’re still working out some glitches but hopefully we’ll improve with practice). FILE OF LIFE CANADA

In the midst of an emergency situation when every second counts, there is chaos and it is hard to think. Trying to answer so many questions can be incredibly stressful and upsetting. Seeing a need to have medical information readily available to medical personnel, Betty Mutch decided to make up a form that would include every detail that medical staff would need to treat a patient more efficiently. That is how and when *File of Life Canada* was born. First responders say, "It can be a real asset to you and medical personnel during these times – it will save countless minutes and possibly save lives."

Basically a miniature medical file, there are two sizes of kits available. The "Refrigerator Kit" includes a decal that you put on your front door or window of your home. Place the red pouch (with a magnetic strip on the back) on the front of your refrigerator door. The pouch contains a card which you fill in with pencil – it includes all the information that medical personnel might need. In the "Wallet Kit," you receive a decal which you place on your driver's door window at the back and bottom (so that it doesn't interfere with sight lines). You fill in the card with pencil and place it in the pouch. Place the pouch in your wallet.

With COVID-19, when a person goes to the hospital, they can't take anyone with them so, for example, if they have a stroke and can't speak, they have no one to speak for them. A *File of Life Canada* can answer the most crucial questions that medical staff might have and when first responders see the decal, they know where to look for your *File of Life Canada*.

File of Life is recognized in all 50 American states so if a person were to travel to the US and get in an accident, first responders will easily recognize the decal on the car window. If the person were to collapse in a store, for example, first responders will look for ID in their wallet. As soon as they see the little pouch, they will know what it is. This could save a life.

File of Life Canada kits are \$10.00 each (plus tax) and are available at the *Independent Grocer* in Doaktown, *Greene's Garden Patch* in Blissfield, and *Foodland* in Blackville as well as several locations in Miramichi.
