

Village residents are advised that the White Goods and Clean up days are as follows:

- Spring White Goods and Clean Up Day : Monday May 31/2021
- Fall White Goods and Clean Up Day: Monday Oct 18/2021

**ACCEPTED:**

You may place Fridges, Stoves, Furniture, Bed Rails, Washers, Dryers, Hot Water Tanks and Paint Cans (only if paint is dried up) at curbside on this day for collection.

**WE DO NOT ACCEPT:**

Sand, Gravel, Rocks , Bricks, Manure, Dead Animals, Car or Snowmobile parts, Propane Tanks, Trees, Lumber, Oil, Construction Materials, Hazardous Waste or items heavier than 50 lbs.

Paint and Batteries can be dropped off at Betts Home Hardware.

Clothing, toys, and dishes can be dropped off at Central NB Self Help.
