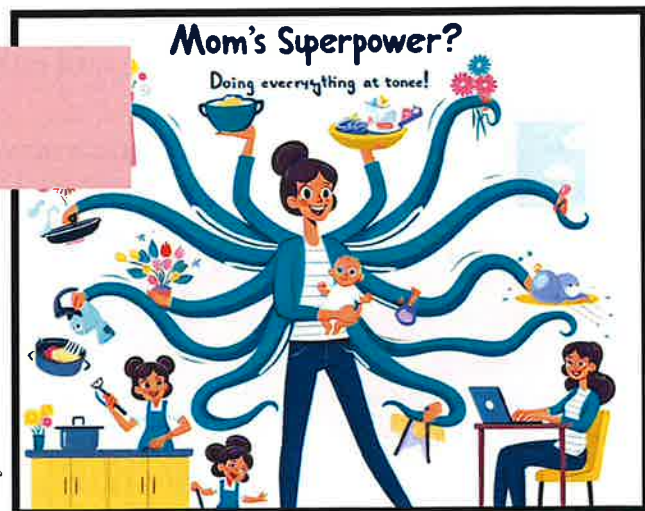


## MOTHERS DAY

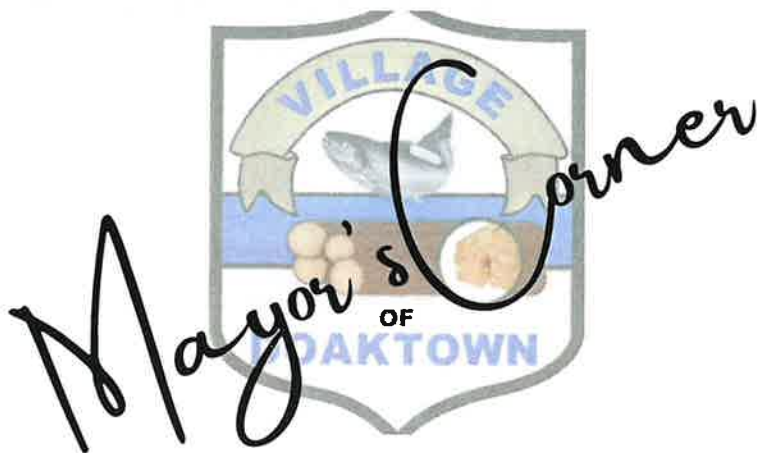
- More phone calls are made on Mother's Day than on any other day of the year.

What a bright outlook to the future as I woke up to sunshine and warm weather on the first day of May! I appreciate the committee indulging in my procrastination and everything they do to keep such a quality newsletter going out to the Village and surrounding area. Well, the National election is in the books, and we have a new Member of Parliament (MP) representing the Miramichi area. I found this election to be quite divisive, and it created animosity between neighbours on a level I have not seen in the past. It's over! Let's pull together now, as the government has been elected in a minority and everyone needs to "pull on the same rope" to ensure we continue to make Canada the best country in the world. Encourage our representative to take our local messages and needs to Ottawa and pray for him as our voice.

On a local perspective we have made some strides over the last month on a few files that Council has been working on. This begins with the construction of a new "Emergency Center" that will be home to our Fire Department, Emergency Measures Organization, Community Warming Center, and Public Works offices. The Village had a contingent meet with three provincial ministers in Marysville to provide a presentation of the events which placed this present building in the poor disrepair it is in as well as the way to a future facility the community envisions. There was a consensus among our group that the pitch was well received and a positive step towards funding.

Housing is also in the forefront for the Doaktown. It is a pleasure to inform the residents we have had three developers step up to initiate projects. There is more than just interest! I truly believe we are moving forward here as there have been submissions to the Greater Miramichi Service Commission Planning Department. If all the plans in the three initiatives come to fruition, Doaktown could have in excess of 20 new dwellings for seniors and affordable housing!

Another file that has been somewhat frustrating, unsightly premises, has finally come to the endgame! The office staff has pushed this "red taped" war for 3 years and two properties have been approved for cleanup, contractors have been hired, and they should be completed by the time you read this. This is not only great for the Village's appearance to visitors but a relief to neighbouring residents that have to look at these "eye sores" every day. They also are unsafe and bring rodents. We will continue to push government to allow us to clean up properties with a better understanding of the procedures.

As all these files we have worked on come together, and there are more, I think of the tight timelines we are now dealing with. The Municipal Elections are less than a year away and the sand in the hour glass is running out! Council will continue to push hard to make these projects realities and turn them over to a new group of community driven residents in the spring of 2026.

Finally, as our Member of the Legislative Assembly moved on to a successful campaign on the Federal level, we are going to a Provincial by-election! There are so many intelligent, hardworking, community oriented residents at this end of the River, step up! We need representation closer to home that knows our issues, our needs, and how special this area is. A voice from the upper end of the Miramichi would be huge for these communities. No matter how it plays out, keep it fair, keep it clean, and keep it respectful!
